## Land release schedule

The Queensland Exploration Program (QEP) land release schedule identifies areas of land being released for competitive tender for petroleum/gas and coal exploration, and provides indicative timings of each tender process.

## Petroleum exploration areas

PLR2023-1 includes seven tender areas across the Bowen and Surat basins. The tender areas provide opportunities for coal seam gas and for conventional and unconventional oil and gas exploration.

<b>PLR2023-1-2</b>	Size Location Basin Commodity	465 km <sup>2</sup> (149 sub-blocks) 18 km south of Rolleston Bowen Coal seam gas and conventional gas
<b>PLR2023-1-3</b>	Size Location Basin Commodity	2024 km <sup>2</sup> (652 sub-blocks) 65 km south south-east of Moura Bowen Conventional and unconventional gas
<b>PLR2023-1-4</b>	Size Location Basin Commodity	238 km <sup>2</sup> (77 sub-blocks) 50 km north north-west of Injune Bowen Coal seam gas and conventional gas
<b>PLR2023-1-5</b>	Size Location Basin Commodity Condition	480 km <sup>2</sup> (156 sub-blocks) 10 km north-west of Injune Bowen Coal seam gas and conventional gas Australian Market Supply Condition
<b>PLR2023-1-6</b>	Size Location Basin Commodity Condition	154 km <sup>2</sup> (50 sub-blocks) 20 km north of Wandoan Bowen Coal seam gas/unconventional gas Australian Market Supply Condition
<b>PLR2023-1-7</b>	Size Location Basin Commodity	526 km <sup>2</sup> (173 sub-blocks) 110 km north-east of St George (three areas) Bowen/Surat Conventional oil and gas and unconventional gas

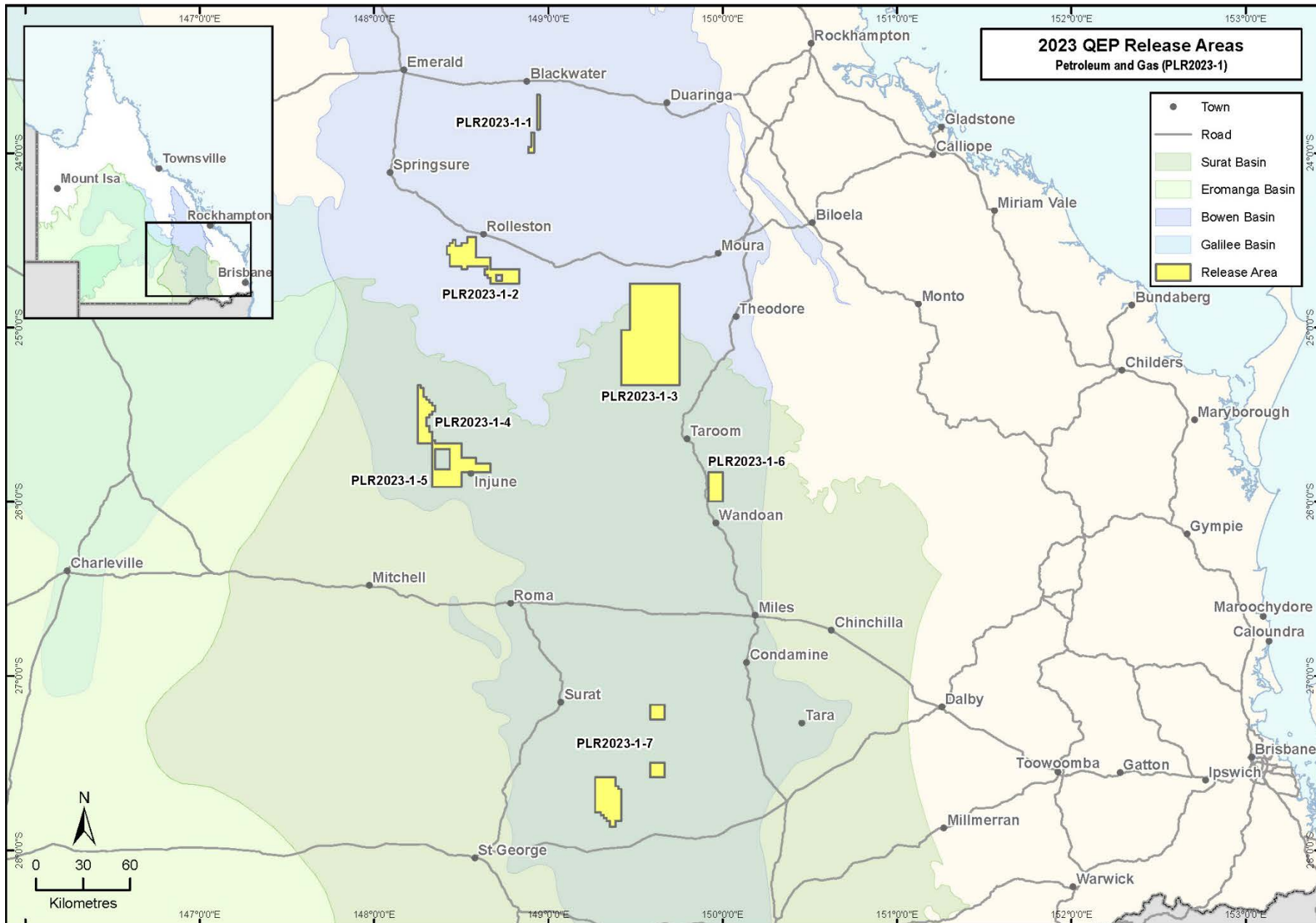
\*It is anticipated that any decision to grant an ATP for the area will involve consideration of a proposal to exclude land from the area of the ATP to the extent the land is within the boundaries of Mining Leases ML1779, ML1799, and ML1771

## Coal exploration areas

CLR2023-1 includes two areas in the Bowen Basin. The tender areas provide opportunities to explore for coal reserves within the geological formations underlying the tender areas.

<b>CLR2023-1-1</b>	Size Location Basin Commodity	22 km <sup>2</sup> (7 sub-blocks) 15 km east of Glenden (two areas) Bowen Metallurgical and thermal coal
<b>CLR2023-1-2</b>	Size Location Basin Commodity	82 km <sup>2</sup> (26 sub-blocks) 20 km north-west and south-west of Rolleston (four areas) Bowen Thermal coal
