



Description of mining operations – Mining Program

This template is intended as a guide to assist applicants/lease holders address the requirements for an application for the grant of or the renewal of a mining lease under the *Mineral Resources Act 1989*.

Section 245 of the *Mineral Resources Act 1989* requires a statement acceptable to the chief executive outlining the mining program proposed for a mining lease application.

The mining program for the renewal of a mining lease is required under section 286 of the *Mineral Resources Act 1989*.

The principal objectives of a mining program are to:

- provide a better understanding of the nature and extent of the proposed development and production of mineral resources from the lease;
- allow an assessment of the proposed development and whether it is appropriate (this
 is particularly important with respect to resources that are not currently being mined or have been
 not developed for some time);
- assess the prospective resource utilisation and identify any resource sterilisation issues; and
- allow appropriate resource management decisions to be made

Scope of mining programs

The scope of mining programs will vary depending on the size and complexity of the proposed mining operations. The plan for an alluvial gold project or a small open cut operation, for instance, would require less detail than a multi-seam open cut and underground operation that also had coal seam gas extraction issues.

4 Method of operations

The mining program should:

- Cover every mineral that the lease holder or applicant has (or will have) the right to mine.
- If the lease was granted for a purpose other than mining, cover the use of the mining lease for the purpose it was granted for.
- Describe the method in enough detail to support the size, shape eg overburden dumps, pits, stockpiles, processing etc.

- Describe the methods proposed for rehabilitation works.
- Include a description of the workforce to establish/maintain this operation.

The mining operations will consist of mining for alluvial gold. The proposed alluvial mining operation will involve the excavation and processing of alluvial sand and gravel from the creek of and adjacent terraces. Terraces will be stripped by an excavator and front loader. The overburden will be stockpiled for rehabilitation purposes in low windrows, less than one meter high, adjacent to the area being mined. The lease area contains vegetation in the form of scattered immature and mature eucalypti and wattles with a minimum of grass cover due to lack of soil. The Applicant, where it is safe and practical to do so, will leave mature trees to reduce environmental impact and enhance the likelihood of natural reseeding of same species.

Alluvial material will be extracted from areas within the mining lease with a tracked excavator. It is intended to extend the mining some 10-15 cm into the softer bedrock in order to extract any gold particles which have lodged in the cleaved sediment. It is likely that some areas will be mobile mined while those that are not, the excavated alluvial material will be transported a short distance to the treatment plant site by a 10-metre capacity tipper truck over a road system following, wherever possible, the bed of the old creek or immediately adjacent banks. Washed gravels will be returned to the former creek course and associated terraces. The plant will produce a crude gold concentrate which will then be further processed elsewhere.

A mobile self-contained camp will be on-site when mining.

Site rehabilitation will be based on progressive rehabilitation carried out during the life of the mining lease to minimise large areas of open disturbance. Two to three years at the end of the production life of the mine is included in the term sort in anticipation of adequate rainfall for the establishment of the vegetation for both cover and the long term stabilisation of the site.
