- This information sheet is a summary only. Please refer to the *Petroleum and Gas (Production and Safety)*Act 2004 and the *Petroleum Act 1923* for further information.
- A petroleum tenure holder may transfer a petroleum well in the area of the tenure to the holder of a geothermal
 exploration permit or a mining tenement if
 - (a) The well is in the area of the permit or tenement; and
 - (b) A notice in the approved form and the transfer fee prescribed under the relevant regulation has been lodged with the Department.
- The tenure holder must return this Notification Form to the department with the signed transfer authority of the holder of the geothermal exploration permit or mining tenement to which the petroleum well applies.
- A "mining tenement" has that definition as contained in Schedule 2 of the *Mineral Resources Act 1989*. The *Mineral Resources Act 1989* defines a "mining tenement" as a prospecting permit, mining claim, exploration permit, mineral development licence or mining lease under that Act.
