- This notice must be lodged with the chief executive, by the petroleum tenure holder, within 10 business days
 after the completion of the conversion of a petroleum well to a water supply bore or water observation bore.
- The petroleum tenure holder must have complied with the requirements, prescribed under the Petroleum and Gas (General Provisions) Regulation 2017 for converting the petroleum well to a water supply bore or water observation bore.
- A drill log form must be lodged with the chief executive within 60 business days of the commencement of the
 conversion of the petroleum well to a water observation bore or water supply bore. A drill log form means the form
 of that name published on the department's website at www.business.qld.gov.au/industry
