## INFORMATION SHEET

### NOTIFICATION OF CONVERSION OF PETROLEUM WELL TO WATER SUPPLY BORE OR WATER OBSERVATION BORE

- This information sheet is a summary only. Please refer to the *Petroleum and Gas (Production and Safety) Act 2004* and the *Petroleum Act 1923* for further information.
- This notice must be lodged with the chief executive, by the petroleum tenure holder, **within 10 business days after the completion of the conversion** of a petroleum well to a water supply bore or water observation bore.
- The petroleum tenure holder must have complied with the requirements, prescribed under the Petroleum and Gas (General Provisions) Regulation 2017 for converting the petroleum well to a water supply bore or water observation bore.
- A drill log form must be lodged with the chief executive within 60 business days of the commencement of the conversion of the petroleum well to a water observation bore or water supply bore.
