

Notice to landowner – mineral development licence access varied

Notes for MDL holder: Once completed this form must be provided to each owner of land over which an access for a mineral development licence has been varied. Provide the form within 15 business days (or any longer period approved by the Minister) of the access being approved to be varied. It is not necessary to lodge a copy with the department. A document containing information that is false or misleading may attract a maximum penalty of 200 penalty units.

This form may be given to the landowner by giving it to them in person, sending it by registered post, or by sending it to the landowner's email address. Email can only be used if the landowner has given the email address to the holder and has not asked for the holder to stop using the email address to communicate with them.
