

Native Title Protection Conditions Form 7 – Clause 6.1(a) Version 4

This is an example of a notice required under the Native Title Protection Conditions. An alternate form that complies with the requirements of the Native Title Protection Conditions may be used instead. The Department has produced this form but takes no responsibility for any subsequent unauthorised changes to it.

Purpose: This form may be used where the **Notified Native Title Parties** are required to provide an Inspection Report to the Explorer.

Definitions of the terms in this form are in Schedule 1 of the Native Title Protection Conditions.

Note : The Inspection Report must include a warranty from its author that all licences, consents and other authorities have been obtained to allow the Explorer to lawfully use and copy the information contained in this Inspection Report for the purposes of operating under the Native Title Protection Conditions, and copying and distributing this report to any assignee of the Explorer.
