Purpose: This form may be used where Notified Native Title Parties are required to give a written notice to an Explorer in response to the Exploration Activity Notice.

Definitions of some of the terms in this form are in Schedule 1 of the Native Title Protection Conditions.

The Notified Native Title Parties do not attend a meeting scheduled by the Explorer (not due to a failure on the part of the Explorer).
