

Native Title Protection Conditions Form 17 – Clause 18.1 Version 4

This is an example of a notice required under the Native Title Protection Conditions. An alternate form that complies with the requirements of the Native Title Protection Conditions may be used instead. The Department has produced this form but takes no responsibility for any subsequent unauthorised changes to it.

Purpose: This form may be used where an Explorer is required to provide written notice to the Notified Native Title Parties after receiving an Inability Notice which states that the Notified Native Title Parties are unable to meet their obligations.

Definitions of some of the terms in this form are in Schedule 1 of the Native Title Protection Conditions.
