## Entry notice for owners and occupiers of land

#### Notes:

Before entry on to private land, a resource authority holder is obligated under section 39(1) of the *Mineral and Energy Resources (Common Provisions) Act 2014* to give notice to each owner and occupier. A maximum penalty of 500 penalty units may apply for breach of this obligation.

A resource authority holder must give the entry notice to the owner and occupier at least 10 business days prior to entry, or a shorter period as agreed with the owner and occupier, before entry onto the land.

This is not a prescribed form but is a template that has been prepared by the Queensland Department of Resources to assist resource authority holders to comply with the prescribed requirements for an entry notice which are set out in section 17 of the Mineral and Energy Resources (Common Provisions) Regulation 2016.

In place of giving an entry notice, the chief executive may also approve that a resource authority holder give an entry notice by publishing in a stated way.
